***Lord Paddick** to ask Her Majesty's Government what impact reductions in local authority funding have had on crime levels.

***Baroness Kramer** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact on the value of the Royal Bank of Scotland shares they hold of the actions of the bank's global restructuring group inside and outside the United Kingdom.

***Lord Lee of Trafford** to ask Her Majesty's Government, in the light of the current Beaufort Securities situation, what steps they are contemplating to ensure that client assets are protected and ring-fenced from administrators of failed stockbroking or fund managements firms operating under rule 135 of the Investment Bank Special Administration (England and Wales) Rules 2011 (SI 2011/1301).

***Lord Foulkes of Cumnock** to ask Her Majesty's Government, following reports of further deaths of those protesting against President Ortega, what representations they are making to the government of Nicaragua to ensure that the human rights of those demonstrating against the President are protected.
