**Oral Questions, 30 minutes*

***Baroness Jones of Moulsecoomb** to ask Her Majesty's Government what is the youngest age at which a child has been authorised to act as a covert human intelligence source under section 29 of the Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000.

***Lord Clement-Jones** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact of changes to arrangements for Certificates of Sponsorship, in particular those affecting artists visiting the United Kingdom for music festivals.

***Baroness Thornhill** to ask Her Majesty's Government, further to the announcement of a Housing Delivery Test in the revised National Planning Policy Framework published 24 July, what measures they will take to prevent developments which do not comply with local plans agreed at a local government level.

***Lord Lee of Trafford** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the current major Russian military exercises, Vostok-2018.

Lord Harries of Pentregarth to move that this House takes note of Part II of the Transparency in Lobbying, Non-Party Campaigning and Trade Union Administration Act 2014 and the effect it has had on third-party election campaigning. (*Balloted debate, 2½ hours*)

Lord Popat to ask Her Majesty's Government what actions they are taking to reassure the Jewish community over the impact of anti-Semitism in the United Kingdom. (*Topical Question for Short Debate, 1 hour*)

Baroness Deech to move that this House takes note of the 40th anniversary of the first baby born using in vitro fertilisation. (*Balloted debate, 2½ hours*)

Lord Alton of Liverpool to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to change the way formal international declarations of genocide or crimes against humanity are made and to further the expeditious prosecution of those responsible. (*1½ hours*)
