**European Union (Withdrawal) Bill** Second Reading [Lord Callanan] *9th Report from the Constitution Committee*

**Lord Adonis** to move, as an amendment to the motion that the bill be now read a second time, at end to insert “but that this House regrets that the bill makes no provision for the opinion of the people to be secured on the terms on which Her Majesty’s Government proposes that the United Kingdom withdraw from the European Union.”

If the bill is read a second time, Lord Callanan to move that the bill be committed to a Committee of the Whole House.

**\*Lord Pearson of Rannoch** to ask Her Majesty’s Government what assessment they have made of the Civitas publication *The Brussels Broadcasting Corporation?* and of the BBC’s coverage of Brexit, set against its new Charter and guidelines.

**\*Baroness Walmsley** to ask Her Majesty’s Government who is conducting the negotiations for the United Kingdom leaving the European Union; and to whom that person reports.

**\*Baroness Featherstone** to ask Her Majesty’s Government what assessment they have made of the ability of companies to apply with consistency the recommendations of the Financial Stability Board’s Taskforce on Climate-related Financial Disclosures.

**\*Baroness Hussein-Ece** to ask Her Majesty’s Government what steps they are taking to protect women who work in the events industry, following reports of harassment at the recent Presidents Club Charity Dinner.
