***Baroness Finn** to ask Her Majesty's Government what are their plans, if any, for the Swansea Tidal Lagoon, following the Hendry Review published in January 2017.

***Baroness Kennedy of The Shaws** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to ensure that non-disclosure agreements are not used to cover up criminal behaviour or silence victims, and that there are no financial or other consequences imposed when a breach of an agreement is in the public interest.

***Baroness Randerson** to ask Her Majesty's Government what is their policy on procurement of the Government's fleet of vehicles.

***Lord Kennedy of Southwark** to ask Her Majesty's Government what action they are taking to ensure the safety of the public in the light of the Association of British Insurers' report, published on 25 April, on fire safety testing of building materials following the Grenfell Tower fire.
