***Lord West of Spithead** to ask Her Majesty's Government whether they still plan to have the first Type 31e frigate in Royal Naval service by 2023.

***Lord Framlingham** to ask Her Majesty's Government what individual representations they have received from other European Union member states about the present state of negotiations for the United Kingdom's withdrawal from the European Union.

***Baroness Anelay of St Johns** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have, if any, to reform divorce laws in England and Wales.

***Lord Haskel** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of demand for debt advice services; and what steps they are taking to reduce the level of household debt.

Lord Aberdare to move that this House takes note of the case for high-quality careers education and advice to be available to all students.

Lord Howell of Guildford to ask Her Majesty's Government what is their response to the Report from the International Relations Committee *The United Nations General Assembly 2018* (4th Report, HL Paper 156). (*1½ hours*)
