**House of Lords (Hereditary Peers) (Abolition of By-Elections) Bill [HL] Committee (day 2) [Lord Grocott]**

**Lord Trefgarne** to move, as an amendment to the motion that the House do now again resolve itself into a Committee on the bill, at end to insert “but regrets that the bill has not been brought forward by the Government, in the light of its constitutional importance; and that the bill proposes piecemeal, rather than wholesale, reform of the membership of the House.”

**Lord Adonis** to move, as an amendment to the motion that the House do now again resolve itself into a Committee on the bill, at end to insert “but regrets that the bill does not provide for a democratic second chamber to replace the existing nominated and hereditary House of Lords; and that the bill does not provide for a democratic second chamber to meet in the north of England.”
