**\*Lord Pearson of Rannoch** to ask Her Majesty's Government whether they will (1) withdraw their notice under clauses 2 to 5 of Article 50 of the Treaty on European Union, and (2) offer through the Council of Ministers continuing free trade under the World Trade Organisation, and residence and security to European Union citizens, before agreeing any financial settlement in the Brexit negotiations.

**\*Baroness Randerson** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to modernise rail fares.

**\*Lord Wallace of Saltaire** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of whether sufficient personnel will be trained and equipment will be ready to take full control of the United Kingdom's borders by the end of March 2019.

**\*Lord Greaves** to ask Her Majesty's Government what proposals they have for new investment in the railway network in the north of England.

**European Union** The Senior Deputy Speaker to move that Lord Ricketts be appointed a member of the Select Committee in place of Lord Crisp, resigned.
