\***Lord Teverson** to ask Her Majesty's Government what action they will take to support the United Kingdom as a global green finance centre following the City of London's fall to third place in the Global Green Finance Index published in September.

\***Baroness Jones of Moulsecoomb** to ask Her Majesty's Government what is their assessment of the safety implications for consumers of the retail sale of weedkillers such as Roundup; and whether they will introduce legislation to address any risks.

\***Lord Fox** to ask Her Majesty's Government what progress they have made in establishing the governance of their Industrial Strategy.

\***Lord Bird** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to ensure that where tenants share payment of rent their individual payment histories will be taken into account by credit service providers.
