**Oral Questions, 30 minutes*

***Lord Kennedy of Southwark** to ask Her Majesty's Government what progress they have made in the general practitioner contract negotiations for 2019–20 to end charges for the provision of evidence of domestic abuse.

***Lord Haskel** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact of work-related stress on productivity.

***Lord Hunt of Kings Heath** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of whether police forces have established effective priorities for fighting crime.

***Lord Bach** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they intend to take to strengthen the ability of police forces in England and Wales to tackle knife and other serious and violent crime in addition to funding provided by the Early Intervention Youth Fund. [I]

†**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that the debates on the motions in the names of Earl Attlee and Baroness Neville-Rolfe set down for today shall each be limited to 2½ hours.

Privileges and Conduct The Senior Deputy Speaker to move that the 2nd Report from the Select Committee (The conduct of Lord Lester of Herne Hill) (HL Paper 220) be agreed to.

Lord Pannick to move, as an amendment to the above motion, to leave out “agreed to” and insert “remitted to the Committee for Privileges and Conduct because the Commissioner for Standards failed to comply with paragraph 21 of the Code of Conduct which required her to act in accordance with the principles of natural justice and fairness.”

If the 2nd Report from the Committee for Privileges and Conduct is agreed to, the Senior Deputy Speaker to move to resolve that, in accordance with Standing Order 12, Lord Lester of Herne Hill be suspended from the service of the House until 3 June 2022; and that, in accordance with section 1 of the House of Lords (Expulsion and Suspension) Act 2015, in the opinion of this House, the conduct giving rise to this resolution occurred before the coming into force of the Act and was not public knowledge before that time.

Earl Attlee to move that this House takes note of Her Majesty's Government's Veterans Strategy.

Lord Luce to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking with international partners to end the conflict in Yemen. (*Topical Question for Short Debate, 1 hour*)

Baroness Neville-Rolfe to move that this House takes note of the threat of plastic to the environment and the case for improved recycling.
