***Lord Bassam of Brighton** to ask Her Majesty's Government whether they plan to introduce new domestic abuse legislation; and if so, when.

***Lord Stevenson of Balmacara** to ask Her Majesty's Government when the review of the Teaching Excellence Framework is due to report and whether this review will include recommendations for judgements to be made on the change in the percentage of first class and upper second class degrees awarded by higher education institutions.
