**Oral Questions, 30 minutes*

***Baroness Thornton** to ask Her Majesty's Government how much of the National Health Service mental health budget goes towards intervention to address domestic and sexual violence and abuse.

***Lord Harrison** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to enable humanist marriage ceremonies.

***Lord Campbell-Savours** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to reform the Inquiries Act 2005 so as to make special provision for the conduct of inquiries into child sexual abuse.

***Lord Lexden** to ask Her Majesty's Government what guidance they provide to local authorities about the provision of support to children with special needs; and what assessment they have made of the cost to local authorities of appeals against their decisions.

Baroness Suttie to move that this House takes note of the progress made across government departments in integrating the Universal Sustainable Developments Goals into domestic policy in preparation for the United Kingdom's Voluntary National Review presentation at the United Nations in September 2019. (*Balloted debate, 2½ hours*)

Lord McConnell of Glenscorrodale to move that this House takes note of the numbers of children displaced from their homes internationally, and the actions undertaken by the Government, the European Union and the United Nations to support them. (*Balloted debate 2½ hours*)
