***The Earl of Clancarty** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to encourage the teaching of art and design in schools.

***Baroness Wilcox** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact of Brexit on the rights of consumers who purchase goods from retailers or manufacturers based in the European Union. [I]

***Lord Greaves** to ask Her Majesty's Government what progress they have made on the improvement and enhancement of railway services across the Pennines.

***Lord West of Spithead** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact on the United Kingdom's future energy needs of any decision by Hitachi to withdraw from the Wylfa Newydd nuclear project and Toshiba having withdrawn from the Moorside project in Cumbria.

†**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that the debate on the motion in the name of Lord Lisvane set down for today shall be limited to 3 hours and that in the name of Baroness Kidron to 2 hours.

Lord Tyler to ask Her Majesty's Government what legislation is necessary to enable a further referendum on the United Kingdom's membership of the European Union to take place in 2019. (*Topical Question for Short Debate, 1 hour*)

Baroness Kidron to move that this House takes note of the relationship between the use of digital technology and the health and wellbeing of children and young people.
