**Oral Questions, 30 minutes*

***Lord Grocott** to ask the Leader of the House what plans she has to make proposals for a review of the powers of the Lord Speaker.

***The Lord Bishop of Gloucester** to ask Her Majesty's Government what progress they have made in implementing the female offenders' strategy.

***Lord Fox** to ask Her Majesty's Government whether they place restrictions on commercial companies seeking to digitally map towns and cities in the United Kingdom; and if not, why not.

***The Lord Bishop of St Albans** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact caused by fly-tipping on areas of outstanding natural beauty, following reports that the Woodland Trust has spent over £1 million on cleaning up fly-tipping over the past five years.

†**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that the debates on the motions in the names of Lord Whitty and Lord Hunt of Kings Heath set down for today shall each be limited to 2½ hours.

Lord Whitty to move that this House takes note of the case for a long-term commitment to increased provision of social housing to help to reduce housing costs, homelessness and housing benefit expenditure.

Viscount Goschen to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the current situation in Zimbabwe. (*Topical Question for Short Debate, 1 hour*)

Lord Hunt of Kings Heath to move that this House takes note of the *NHS Long Term Plan*, published on 7 January, and the case for a fully funded, comprehensive and integrated health and care system which implements parity of esteem, preventative health and standards set out in the NHS Constitution.
