***Lord Clark of Windermere** to ask Her Majesty's Government when they intend to publish the NHS Workforce Implementation Plan which was announced in the *NHS Long Term Plan*, published on 7 January.

***Baroness Rawlings** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to review security in the vicinity of the Palace of Westminster.

***Baroness McIntosh of Pickering** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to pause the Article 50 process.

***Lord Hunt of Kings Heath** to ask Her Majesty's Government what is their response to the assessment of the President of the Royal College of Emergency Medicine that removing the four-hour accident and emergency treatment target would have a "near-catastrophic impact" on patient safety in many emergency departments.

Lord Naseby to ask Her Majesty's Government, following the resignation of the government of the United States from the United Nations Human Rights Council where they co-sponsored with the United Kingdom Resolution 30/1 in 2015 and Resolution 34/1 in 2017, in regard to Sri Lanka, and given the progress made towards many aspects highlighted in the resolutions, what assessment they have made of whether to annul or withdraw those resolutions.
