***Lord Hoyle** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to ensure the use of more British steel in defence contracts.

***Baroness Massey of Darwen** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to develop a cross-departmental action plan to address the conclusions and recommendations of the United Nations Committee on the Rights of the Child's assessment of the United Kingdom in 2016, in order to ensure that all public bodies act to protect and promote children's rights.

***Lord Campbell-Savours** to ask Her Majesty's Government what further discussions they have had, and with whom, about the benefits of the introduction of identity cards.

†***Baroness Cox** to ask Her Majesty's Government what is their response to recent developments in Sudan.
