**Oral Questions, 30 minutes*

***Baroness Randerson** to ask Her Majesty's Government what measures they plan to introduce to encourage local authorities to install more charging points for electric vehicles.

***Lord Kirkhope of Harrogate** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to proceed with a devolution process for Yorkshire which takes into account (1) rural and urban interests, and (2) the services and industrial sectors, and reunites the historic Yorkshire Ridings.

***Lord Dubs** to ask Her Majesty's Government what their latest proposals are to reduce the use of plastics.

†***Lord Bird** to ask Her Majesty's Government, further to the climate emergency declarations by the First Minister of Scotland on 28 April, the Welsh Government Minister for Environment, Energy and Rural Affairs on 29 April, and the House of Commons on 1 May, what plans they have to formally announce a climate emergency in the United Kingdom.

If the bill is read a second time, Lord Gardiner of Kimble to move that the bill be committed to a Committee of the Whole House.

Financial Services (Miscellaneous) (Amendment) (EU Exit) (No. 2) Regulations 2019 Lord Young of Cookham to move that the draft Regulations laid before the House on 3 April be approved.

Lord Black of Brentwood to ask Her Majesty's Government what progress they have made towards Public Health England's target to increase the proportion of known atrial fibrillation patients who are offered and started on appropriate treatment to 89 per cent by 2021. (*1½ hours*)
