***Baroness Burt of Solihull** to ask Her Majesty's Government, further to the remarks by the Chancellor of the Exchequer on 13 March (HC Deb, col 352), what steps they are taking to ensure that free sanitary products will be available in secondary schools and colleges in England from the next school year.

***Baroness Janke** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to address the concerns raised by teachers in, and the findings of, the survey on child poverty published by the National Education Union on 14 April.

***Lord McNicol of West Kilbride** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to address increases in homelessness.

†***Baroness Jenkin of Kennington** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have, if any, for an inquiry into how family courts in England and Wales treat victims of domestic violence.
