\***Baroness McIntosh of Pickering** to ask Her Majesty's Government when they expect the Office for Environmental Protection to be operational; what its remit will be; and in the interim, which body will ensure compliance with environmental protection legislation and regulations.

\***Lord Bruce of Bennachie** to ask Her Majesty's Government when they plan to introduce British Sign Language into the school examination curriculum.

\***Baroness Boycott** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to maintain appropriate standards in the delivery of free school meals.

\***Lord Kennedy of Southwark** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to review the donation rules for political parties.

**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that Standing Order 40(4) (so far as it relates to Thursdays) and (5) be suspended until the end of the session so far as it is necessary to enable notices and orders relating to Public Bills initiated by Her Majesty's Government concerning the United Kingdom's withdrawal from the European Union to have precedence over other motions and orders on Thursdays.

**Lord Bourne of Aberystwyth** to move that this House takes note of the 20th anniversary of devolution in the United Kingdom and the role of the devolved administrations in the governance of Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.
