**Oral Questions, 30 minutes*

***Baroness Deech** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to promote gender equality in the composition of the House of Lords.

***Lord Alton of Liverpool** to ask Her Majesty's Government how much United Kingdom aid has been given to Pakistan in the last ten years; and what assessment they have made of the extent to which this was used to support persecuted minorities in that country.

***Baroness Armstrong of Hill Top** to ask Her Majesty's Government whether they have plans to review the childcare system.

***Baroness Cox** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of recent events in Sudan, following attacks against protestors by Sudanese security forces.

Business of the House The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that Standing Order 46 (*No two stages of a Bill to be taken on one day*) be dispensed with on Tuesday 11 June to allow the Non-Domestic Rating (Preparation for Digital Services) Bill (*Money Bill*) to be taken through its remaining stages that day.

†**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that the debates on the motions in the names of Baroness Newlove and Lord Leigh of Hurley set down for today shall each be limited to 2½ hours.

The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) intends to move the following four motions en bloc: but if any Lord objects the motions must be moved separately to the extent desired.

Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that it is desirable that a Select Committee be appointed to consider post-legislative scrutiny of the Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013, and that the Committee do report by 31 March 2020.

Social and Economic Impact of the Gambling Industry The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that it is desirable that a Select Committee be appointed to consider the social and economic impact of the gambling industry, and that the Committee do report by 31 March 2020.

Democracy and Digital Technologies The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that it is desirable that a Select Committee be appointed to consider democracy and digital technologies, and that the Committee do report by 31 March 2020.

Food, Poverty, Health and the Environment The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that it is desirable that a Select Committee be appointed to consider the links between inequality, public health and food sustainability, and that the Committee do report by 31 March 2020.

Baroness Newlove to move that this House takes note of Her Majesty's Government's plans to support victims of domestic violence and abuse.

Baroness Thornton to ask Her Majesty's Government what action they are taking to address the treatment of people with learning disabilities and complex needs in in-patient units; and what plans they have to provide adequate, alternative community support. (*Topical Question for Short Debate, 1 hour*)

Lord Leigh of Hurley to move that this House takes note of the latest employment figures and the steps being taken by Her Majesty's Government to increase employment rates.

Church Representation and Ministers Measure The Lord Bishop of Leeds to move that this House do direct that, in accordance with the Church of England Assembly (Powers) Act 1919, the Church Representation and Ministers Measure be presented to Her Majesty for the Royal Assent.

Sentencing (Pre-consolidation Amendments) Bill [HL] (*Law Commission Bill*) Lord Keen of Elie to move that the bill be referred to a Second Reading Committee.
