***Lord Alton of Liverpool** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact of the government of Hong Kong's proposed new extradition law on (1) the autonomy of Hong Kong, and (2) its Basic Law guaranteeing the rights and freedoms of its citizens.
