***The Earl of Clancarty** to ask Her Majesty's Government what support they are giving to people suffering from asthma, including on access to medicines.

***Lord Clark of Windermere** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the level of bullying, harassment and abuse in the National Health Service in England.

***Lord Kennedy of Southwark** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to remove any impediments to selling public land to local authorities or housing associations at below its market value in order to increase the number of affordable houses. [1]

***Lord Lexden** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the petition calling for anonymity for those accused of sexual offences until charged.

Baroness Smith of Basildon to move that, further to the resolutions of this House on 14 and 28 January, and that of the House of Commons on 14 March, it is expedient that a joint committee of Lords and Commons be appointed to consider and report on the costs and implications for the United Kingdom of exiting the European Union without a withdrawal agreement on 31 October 2019, and that the committee should report its findings by 30 September 2019.
