***Baroness Jones of Moulsecoomb** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to adjust carbon budgets in the light of past performance and the Paris Agreement.

***Lord Lennie** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the roll-out of smart meters.

***Baroness Tonge** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the treatment of Palestinian children by the Israel Defense Forces.

Parliamentary Buildings (Restoration and Renewal) Bill Second Reading [The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park)]

If the bill is read a second time, the Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that the bill be committed to a Committee of the Whole House.

†**Lord Adonis** to move to resolve that this House regrets that the Parliamentary Buildings (Restoration and Renewal) Bill fails to include the option of relocating Parliament to a city outside London as a means of rebalancing the constitution of the United Kingdom, which is over-centralised on London.

Lord Howell of Guildford to ask Her Majesty's Government, following the recent G20 Summit in Osaka, Japan, and the letter relating to the summit from the International Relations Committee to the Prime Minister, dated 13 June, which outcomes they judge to be of most importance for the safeguarding and furtherance of Britain's national interests.
