*\*Oral Questions, 30 minutes*

\***Lord Clement-Jones** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of (1) the imposition, and (2) the operation, of public spaces protection orders.

\***Baroness Gardner of Parkes** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the availability of National Health Service dentistry services.

\***Lord West of Spithead** to ask Her Majesty's Government whether the number of frigates in commission available for operations will fall below 13 in any year before 2026.

\***Lord Bates** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking with international partners to de-escalate tensions in the Gulf of Oman.

**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that Standing Order 46 (*No two stages of a Bill to be taken on one day*) be dispensed with on Tuesday 16 July to allow the Supply and Appropriation (Main Estimates) (No. 3) Bill to be taken through its remaining stages that day.

**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that Standing Orders 46 (*No two stages of a Bill to be taken on one day*) and 48 (*Amendments on Third Reading*) be dispensed with on Wednesday 17 July to allow the Report stage and Third Reading of the Northern Ireland (Executive Formation) Bill to be taken on that day and to allow manuscript amendments to be tabled and moved on Third Reading.

†**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that the debate on the motion in the name of Baroness Neville-Rolfe set down for today shall be limited to 2 hours and that in the name of Lord Elton to 3 hours.

**Baroness Neville-Rolfe** to move that this House takes note of the case for creating an environment which encourages (1) business growth, and (2) job creation, especially in relation to the tax system.

**The Lord Bishop of St Albans** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the Church of England's social media community guidelines, published on 1 July, and what steps they are taking to promote positive social media behaviour. (*Topical Question for Short Debate, 1 hour*)

**Lord Elton** to move that this House takes note of the extent of persecution of people of faith in this century.
