\***Lord Singh of Wimbledon** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the recommendations of the Bishop of Truro's Independent Review of the Foreign and Commonwealth Office's support for persecuted Christians.

\***Lord Scriven** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the human rights situation in Bahrain over the last two years and whether that assessment was made independently of the government of Bahrain.

\***Baroness Sheehan** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact of climate change on the livelihoods of people in the Sahel region of Africa.

\***Lord Berkeley** to ask Her Majesty's Government, further to reports that the cost of the High Speed 2 rail project will not be delivered within its current budget, what steps they are taking to ensure that the costs of that project remain within its budget.
