***Lord Sharkey** to ask Her Majesty's Government what progress is being made towards the introduction of Sharia-compliant student finance.

***Lord Collins of Highbury** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the Final Judgment and Summary of the Independent Tribunal into Forced Organ Harvesting from Prisoners of Conscience in China, published on 17 June.

***Baroness Wheeler** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the *Association of Directors of Adult Social Service Budget Survey 2019* on the state of adult social care.

***The Lord Bishop of St Albans** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to help those areas affected by the latest outbreak of Ebola which has been declared a Public Health Emergency of International Concern by the World Health Organization.

Baroness Quin to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact of the leaking of confidential messages from Sir Kim Darroch and their subsequent publication. (*Topical Question for Short Debate, 1 hour*)

Lord Farmer to move that this House takes note of the needs of women in the criminal justice system. (*Balloted debate, 2½ hours*)
