**Oral Questions, 30 minutes*

***Baroness Randerson** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to encourage more people to travel by bus.

***Baroness Wheeler** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking (1) to improve access to palliative care, rehabilitation and psychosocial care for people living with a brain tumour, and (2) to provide support for their carers and families.

***Baroness Sheehan** to ask Her Majesty's Government what progress has been made to eradicate polio in (1) Pakistan, and (2) Afghanistan.

***Lord West of Spithead** to ask Her Majesty's Government whether any British Armed Forces, in particular air assets, are involved in operations over Syria identifying and targeting ISIL.

†**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that the debate on the motion in the name of Lord Greaves set down for today shall be limited to 2 hours and that in the name of Lord Alton of Liverpool to 3 hours.

Lord Greaves to move that this House takes note of the levels of government support for neighbourhood services provided by district councils and other local authorities. (*Balloted debate*)

Lord McConnell of Glenscorrodale to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the situation in Syria and Iraq following Turkey's invasion of Syria. (*Topical Question for Short Debate, 1 hour*)

Lord Alton of Liverpool to move that this House takes note of the recent political unrest in Hong Kong, and of the calls to offer residents of Hong Kong citizenship in another country. (*Balloted debate*)
