\***Lord Bassam of Brighton** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to continue participation in the Horizon 2020 programme beyond the Brexit transition period.

\***Baroness Donaghy** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the availability of children's emergency beds in the National Health Service in England; and whether they have a strategy for addressing any shortfall.

\***Baroness Meacher** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to improve support for children excluded from mainstream schools.

\***The Lord Bishop of St Albans** to ask Her Majesty's Government whether food production is included in the definition of "public good" contained in the Agriculture Bill.

If the bill is read a second time, Baroness Vere of Norbiton to move that the bill be committed to a Committee of the Whole House.
