†\***Baroness Lister of Burtersett** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the Office for National Statistics' release *Average household income, UK: financial year ending 2019*, published on 5 March, and in particular the finding that disposable household income has fallen for the poorest 20 per cent of the population.
