\***Lord Trefgarne** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they propose to take to reduce the amount of illegal fly-tipping, particularly in rural areas.

\***Lord Collins of Highbury** to ask Her Majesty's Government what recent discussions they have had with the government of Rwanda and the Commonwealth Secretariat on (1) progress on implementing the action points since the Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting held in London in April 2018, and (2) arrangements for exchanges with Commonwealth Heads of Government as a consequence of the postponement of the June 2020 meeting.

\***Lord Balfe** to ask the Senior Deputy Speaker what consideration has been given by the Procedure Committee to bringing before the House a resolution to amend Standing Orders to provide that the House should reduce the number of introductions of new peers annually to the number recommended in the report of the Lord Speaker's Committee on the Size of the House.
