At 12 noon, oral questions (40 minutes)

***Baroness D'Souza** to ask Her Majesty's Government what (1) diplomatic, and (2) practical, assistance they are providing to the government of Taiwan; and what plans they have to formally recognise Taiwan as an independent sovereign state.

***Baroness Sheehan** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to ensure that a COVID-19 vaccine, if developed, is (1) available to, and (2) affordable for, low- and middle-income countries.

***Lord Haskel** to ask Her Majesty's Government whether clauses (1) protecting human rights, and (2) maintaining environmental standards, will be inserted in the trade agreements being negotiated as a result of the United Kingdom's departure from the European Union.

***Baroness Thornton** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to ensure that ethnic diversity is fully reflected in all aspects of medical teaching and learning.
