***Lord Holmes of Richmond** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact of digital platforms on the functioning of democracy.

***Lord Harris of Haringey** to ask Her Majesty's Government what progress they have made towards the implementation of the recommendations in the report by the Independent Advisory Panel on Deaths in Custody *'Keep Talking, Stay Safe': A Rapid Review of Prisoners' Experience under COVID-19*, published on 31 May.

***The Lord Bishop of Bristol** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on human trafficking in the United Kingdom.
