*At 12 noon, oral questions (40 minutes)*

\***Lord Grocott** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the case for an upper limit on the number of members of the House of Lords.

\***Lord Kennedy of Southwark** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to ensure that any changes to the planning system will improve (1) building standards, (2) safety, (3) environmental impacts, and (4) the well-being of residents. [1]

\***Lord Harries of Pentregarth** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of (1) the level of the pollution in rivers in England, and (2) the causes.

\***Lord Teverson** to ask Her Majesty's Government, following the report by the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds, *A lost decade for nature*, published on 14 September, what action they are taking (1) to reverse biodiversity loss in the United Kingdom, and (2) to meet the Aichi Biodiversity Targets.

†**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that the debate on the motion in the name of Lord True set down for Wednesday 23 September be limited to 4½ hours and not 3 hours.

†**Immigration and Social Security Co-ordination (EU Withdrawal) Bill** Baroness Williams of Trafford to move that, if the bill's Committee stage is not concluded by the rise of the House on Wednesday 16 September, the bill be reported from the Committee of the Whole House in respect of proceedings up to that date; and that, for the remainder of the bill, the order of commitment of 22 July 2020 be discharged and the bill be committed to a Grand Committee.
