Oral questions (40 minutes)

***Baroness Greengross** to ask Her Majesty's Government, following the suspension of all casework by the Local Government and Social Care Ombudsman between 26 March and 29 June due to the COVID-19 pandemic, what steps they have taken to ensure that complaints made during that period were handled in line with the Local Authority Social Services and National Health Service Complaints (England) Regulations 2009; and what steps they are now taking to ensure that complaints about adult social care are handled appropriately.

***Baroness Bakewell** to ask Her Majesty's Government what provisions they have put in place to meet the needs of those with learning difficulties and autism during the COVID-19 pandemic.

***Baroness McDonagh** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact on primary and secondary school students' ability to learn for those students (1) who have digital connectivity, and (2) who do not have such connectivity, when learning from home due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

***Baroness McIntosh of Pickering** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact of quarantine provisions to address the COVID-19 pandemic on civil aviation; and what measures they plan to take to support the aviation sector.
