***Baroness Deech** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the future of historic statues in England.

***Lord Alton of Liverpool** to ask Her Majesty's Government what estimate they have made of the costs of their decision to appeal the decision of the High Court on 19 December 2019 in *Project for the Registration of Children as British Citizens versus Home Office*.

***Lord Hunt of Kings Heath** to ask Her Majesty's Government, further to the Written Ministerial Statement by Baroness Berridge on 22 September (HLWS457), what further advice they intend to give to public bodies following the conclusion of the review of the Gender Recognition Act 2004.

***Lord Bradshaw** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to decrease journey times for trains that use the Nottingham to Lincoln corridor to connect with other cities in the East Midlands.
