***Baroness Ritchie of Downpatrick** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the report by the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change *Climate Change 2021: The Physical Science Basis*, published on 9 August.

***Baroness Royall of Blaisdon** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to protect the (1) freedoms, and (2) rights, of women and girls in Afghanistan.

***Lord Holmes of Richmond** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to amend competition law to enable collective action to ensure an efficient, effective, accessible, and sustainable cash network across the United Kingdom.

***Lord Berkeley** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to reduce the risk of vehicles hitting railway bridges in order to improve rail passenger safety and reduce disruption.
