*Oral questions (40 minutes)*

\***Lord Cruddas** to ask Her Majesty's Government what discussions they have had, if any, with (1) Transport for London, and (2) the Mayor of London, in relation to the abolition of temporary cycle lanes in London.

\***The Lord Bishop of London** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the availability of places for nomadic Gypsies and Travellers to legally and safely stop; and what plans they have to address any identified shortage of places.

\***Baroness Thornhill** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to introduce legislation prohibiting second homes advertised as holiday rentals from avoiding council tax by registering for business rates and thereby qualifying for small business rate relief.

\***Lord Holmes of Richmond** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to undertake an inquiry into the reasons why the COP26 summit venue did not provide equal access for people with disabilities; and what steps they are taking to ensure that similar events in future are accessible to all.

**Baroness Featherstone** to move that this House takes note of the impact of Her Majesty's Government's policy and spending on the creative sector in the United Kingdom. *(3 hours)*

**Lord Clement-Jones** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the use of facial and other biometric recognition technologies in schools. *(Topical Question for Short Debate, 1 hour)*

**Lord Stunell** to move that this House takes note of the situation of leaseholders who are facing substantial bills for fire and building safety remediation work; and of the need for safe, green and affordable housing. *(2 hours)*
