\***Baroness Hayter of Kentish Town** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the case for designating all Members of the House of Lords as Politically Exposed Persons for the purposes of anti money laundering rules.

\***Baroness Crawley** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have, if any, to support the White Ribbon campaign which seeks to end male violence against women.

\***Lord McConnell of Glenscorrodale** to ask Her Majesty's Government when they will publish their international development strategy.

\***Lord Young of Cookham** to ask Her Majesty's Government how many Afghan refugees accepted under Operation Warm Welcome are currently living in hotels.

**Lord Alton of Liverpool** to move that this House takes note of the reported remarks of the Secretary of State for Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Affairs that a genocide is underway against the Uyghur population in Xinjiang, China. *(Balloted debate, 3 hours)*

**Baroness Hoey** to move that this House takes note of the number of migrants arriving in the United Kingdom illegally by boat. *(Balloted debate, 2 hours)*

**Money Laundering and Terrorist Financing (Amendment) (No. 3) (High-Risk Countries) Regulations 2021** Lord Agnew of Oulton to move that the Regulations laid before the House on 1 November be approved.

**Terrorism Act 2000 (Proscribed Organisations) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order 2021** Baroness Williams of Trafford to move that the draft Order laid before the House on 19 November be approved.
