\***Lord Holmes of Richmond** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to review the operation of the Disabled Students' Allowance scheme to ensure it is working in a timely manner and in the best interests of those it is set up to support.

\***Lord Hannay of Chiswick** to ask Her Majesty's Government what the United Kingdom's contribution to the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees (UNRWA) is in the current year and next year; and what steps they are taking to ensure that UNRWA does not run out of funds.

\***Baroness Jones of Whitchurch** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to ensure small family farms remain economically viable during the transition to the Future Farming Programme for England.

\***Lord Moylan** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to ensure the uninterrupted supply of all medicines to Northern Ireland from the end of this year.

**Baroness Fraser of Craigmaddie** to move that this House takes note of Scotland's contribution to economic recovery and renewal, and how this may support wellbeing and quality of life across the United Kingdom. (*2½ hours*)

**Lord Davies of Brixton** to ask Her Majesty's Government when they will announce the details of any further Extraordinary Funding and Financing Agreement for Transport for London for the period after 11 December. (*Topical Question for Short Debate, 1 hour*)

**Lord Howell of Guildford** to move that this House takes note of the role of civil nuclear power in meeting the United Kingdom's electricity needs and energy security. (*2½ hours*)
