\***Lord Jordan** to ask Her Majesty's Government, further to the International Trade Union Confederation (ITUC) report *Holding eSwatini to Account: Assessing the Country's Compliance with the Commonwealth Charter*, published on 5 March 2021, what plans they have to use their position as a member of the Commonwealth Ministerial Action Group to initiate an investigation into potential breaches of the Commonwealth Charter by the government of Eswatini; and what steps they will take to support the implementation of the recommendations in the ITUC report.

\***Lord Balfe** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the change in the United Kingdom's diplomatic influence since it ceased to be a participant in the political cooperation meetings of the European Union.

\***The Lord Bishop of Coventry** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to reconcile differences between nuclear possessor states and non-nuclear possessor states at the Review Conference of the Parties to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons.

\***Lord Dodds of Duncairn** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact of rising energy prices on the most vulnerable people in society, and the most effective means of helping them.
