\***Lord Wood of Anfield** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the causes of food insecurity in England.

\***Lord Hunt of Kings Heath** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they are taking to address the delays experienced by patients trying to access their GP. [I]

†\***Lord Dubs** to ask Her Majesty's Government how many Ukrainian asylum seekers and refugees have arrived in the United Kingdom since the invasion of Ukraine by Russia.

**Identity and Language (Northern Ireland) Bill [HL]** Second Reading [Lord Caine]

If the bill is read a second time, Lord Caine to move that the bill be committed to a Grand Committee.

**The Earl of Clancarty** to move that this House regrets that the Immigration (Restrictions on Employment and Residential Accommodation) (Prescribed Requirements and Codes of Practice) and Licensing Act 2003 (Personal and Premises Licences) (Forms), Etc., Regulations 2022 do not provide an option of a physical proof of status; do not heed the recommendations of the report from the 2018 beta assessment of the Home Office's 'prove your right to work' scheme; and have been introduced without being subject to an impact assessment (SI 2022/242).
