***Baroness McIntosh of Pickering** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the numbers of households in fuel poverty; and what steps they are taking to address this. [I]

***Baroness Wilcox of Newport** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the number of occasions that legislative consent has been rejected by the devolved legislatures since December 2019; whether they still intend to abide by the Sewel Convention; and if so, what steps they are taking to ensure that consent is secured to legislation in future.
