Oral questions (40 minutes)

***Lord Haskel** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the survey by the British Retail Consortium, published on 17 May, which concluded that the apprenticeship levy scheme was "not fit for purpose"; and what steps they intend to take to modify that scheme.

***Earl Attlee** to ask Her Majesty's Government until what age a newly recruited prison officer must stay in post before they are able to claim their full occupational pension.

***Lord Dubs** to ask Her Majesty's Government how much money they have allocated from the Official Development Assistance budget to (1) Ukraine, and (2) each of its neighbouring countries, since the Russian invasion in February.

***Lord West of Spithead** to ask Her Majesty's Government whether the usage rates by Ukrainian forces of weapons supplied by the United Kingdom aligns with their predictions; and whether they intend to reassess (1) their supply of weapons to that country, and (2) the stockholding required by the UK's armed forces.

The Senior Deputy Speaker intends to move the following two motions en bloc: but if any Lord objects the motions must be moved separately.

Procedure and Privileges The Senior Deputy Speaker to move that Baroness Taylor of Bolton be appointed a member of the Select Committee.

Public Services The Senior Deputy Speaker to move that Baroness Morris of Yardley be appointed a member of the Select Committee, in place of Lord Hunt of Kings Heath.

Lord Norton of Louth to move that this House takes note of the case for both Houses of Parliament to continue to be co-located in the same city. (*Balloted debate, 3 hours*)

Baroness Tyler of Enfield to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the report by the Royal College of Nursing *Nursing Under Unsustainable Pressure: Staffing for Safe and Effective Care*, published on 6 June. (*Topical Question for Short Debate, 1 hour*)

Baroness Harris of Richmond to move that this House takes note of the state of the pig farming industry in England. (*Balloted debate, 2 hours*)
