Oral questions (40 minutes)

***The Lord Bishop of Derby** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment that have made of the *Independent Review of Children's Social Care*, published on 23 May; and what plans they have to make experience of being in care a protected characteristic under the Equality Act 2010.

***Lord West of Spithead** to ask Her Majesty's Government whether the recently announced Ocean Surveillance Ship and National Flagship will be built concurrently; and when those vessels are expected to enter service with the Royal Navy.

***Baroness Wheeler** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the survey by the Association of Directors of Adult Care, published on 13 May, which found that more than 500,000 people in England were waiting (1) for a social care assessment, (2) for their care package to begin, or (3) for a review of their care.

***Baroness Hayman of Ullock** to ask Her Majesty's Government, further to their *English Housing Survey: a segmentation analysis of private renters*, published on 16 June, what plans they have to improve conditions for private renters.

Procedure and Privileges The Senior Deputy Speaker to move that the Report from the Select Committee *Revision of the Companion to the Standing Orders* (2nd Report, HL Paper 17) be agreed to.
