*Oral questions (40 minutes)*

\***Lord Brooke of Alverthorpe** to ask Her Majesty's Government what was the business case for not recording the percentage of patients who joined the Diabetic Prevention Programme between 2018 and 2019 but failed to complete the course; and whether this information is now recorded.

\***Lord Touhig** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the barriers preventing families with disabled children from adequately receiving support services.

\***Baroness Chakrabarti** to ask Her Majesty's Government what plans they have to encourage compliance with the Convention on Human Rights (1) in the United Kingdom, and (2) across Europe.

\***Lord Davies of Brixton** to ask Her Majesty's Government when they expect to announce the details of any further Extraordinary Funding and Financing Agreement for Transport for London (TfL) for the period after 24 June; and when they expect that there will be a long-term solution to funding TfL.

**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Baroness Evans of Bowes Park) to move that, in the event of the Social Security (Additional Payments) Bill having been brought from the House of Commons, Standing Order 44 (*No two stages of a Bill to be taken on one day*) be dispensed with on Monday 27 June to allow the Bill to be taken through its remaining stages that day.

**Lord Morse** to move that this House takes note of the impact on the democratic process of any reduction in the standards of behaviour and honesty in political life. (*3 hours*)

**Lord Lisvane** to move that this House takes note of the stresses upon the Union of the United Kingdom. *10th Report, Session 2021–22, from the Constitution Committee (2 hours)*
