\***Lord Blunkett** to ask Her Majesty's Government what discussions they have had with representatives of the insurance industry regarding the use of age as a trigger for substantial increases in premiums for travel and other related cover.

\***Viscount Hanworth** to ask Her Majesty's Government when, and under what circumstances, they will place orders for small modular nuclear reactors.

\***Baroness Anelay of St Johns** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the progress made during their term as Chair-in-Office of the Commonwealth towards building a Commonwealth that is fairer, prosperous, more sustainable and more secure.

\***The Lord Bishop of St Albans** to ask Her Majesty's Government what representations they have made to the government of Russia and the unrecognised Donetsk People's Republic (DPR) on behalf of British nationals Aiden Aslin and Shaun Pinner, following their death sentence by a court in the DPR.
