*Oral questions (40 minutes)*

\***Baroness Cox** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the humanitarian and security situation in Nigeria.

\***Baroness Hayter of Kentish Town** to ask Her Majesty's Government what was the outcome of their review of money laundering regulations in respect of their impact on Politically Exposed Persons.

\***Lord Clement-Jones** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the decision by the Information Commissioner's Office to fine and issue an enforcement notice against Clearview AI Inc. in respect of its use of images of United Kingdom residents collected from the internet without their knowledge or consent.

†\***Lord Woodley** to ask Her Majesty's Government what discussions they have had with (1) employers, (2) employment agencies, and (3) trade unions, about their plans to remove regulation 7 of the Conduct Regulations 2003 to allow agency staff to cover for striking workers.

*It is expected that the following two motions will be debated together: when the first motion has been agreed to the Senior Deputy Speaker will move the second motion formally, to enable the House to come to a decision.*

**Procedure and Privileges** The Senior Deputy Speaker to move that this House takes note of the Report from the Select Committee *Sitting times of the House: information relevant to the House's decision* (1st Report, HL Paper 12).

**Sitting Times** The Senior Deputy Speaker, on behalf of the Procedure and Privileges Committee, to move to resolve that, with effect from 6 September 2022, this House should sit at 1pm on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, normally rising by 8.30pm on those days.

**Lord Forsyth of Drumlean** to move, as an amendment to the motion in the name of the Senior Deputy Speaker, leave out from "move" to the end and insert "that this House continues with its current sitting arrangements".

**Lord Taylor of Holbeach** to move, as an amendment to the motion in the name of the Senior Deputy Speaker, leave out from "move" to the end and insert "that this House defers consideration on changing its sitting times until a consultation has taken place on a range of available options and the consequences of any change to the workings of the House are fully explored and explained".

**Lord Balfe** to move, as an amendment to the amendment by Lord Taylor of Holbeach, to insert after "options", "including the option that divisions should not normally take place after 8pm".

**Lord Young of Cookham** to move, as an amendment to the motion in the name of the Senior Deputy Speaker, at the end insert "and that these arrangements end at the Christmas recess unless renewed by a resolution of the House".

**Police Act 1996 (Amendment and Consequential Amendments) Regulations 2022** Baroness Williams of Trafford to move that the draft Regulations laid before the House on 9 June be approved.

**Financial Services Act 2021 (Prudential Regulation of Credit Institutions and Investment Firms) (Consequential Amendments and Miscellaneous Provisions) Regulations 2022** Baroness Penn to move that the draft Regulations laid before the House on 13 June be approved.

†**Armed Forces Act (Continuation) Order 2022** Baroness Goldie to move that the draft Order laid before the House on 13 June be approved.
