***Lord Kennedy of Southwark** to ask Her Majesty's Government what steps they propose to take to ensure service charges paid by leaseholders are fair and reasonable. [I]

***Lord Harris of Haringey** to ask Her Majesty's Government what is their current estimate of the total cost of the Emergency Services Mobile Communications Programme; how this compares with the original estimate; and when they expect the Emergency Services Network will be rolled out fully.

***Lord Foulkes of Cumnock** to ask Her Majesty's Government what is their current policy in respect of any request from the Scottish Parliament for a further referendum on independence.

***Lord Foster of Bath** to ask Her Majesty's Government when they will publish the Gambling White Paper.
