†\***Baroness Merron** to ask Her Majesty's Government how they are monitoring and assessing the transition of Clinical Commissioning Groups to Integrated Care Boards; and how the success and impact of the new structure will be evaluated and reported to Parliament.

†\***Baroness Bennett of Manor Castle** to ask Her Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the benefits of a four-day working week as standard.
