*Oral questions (40 minutes)*

\***Lord Brooke of Alverthorpe** to ask His Majesty's Government what plans they have to extend the use of health taxes in the wider fiscal system.

\***Baroness Jones of Moulsecoomb** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the impact of (1) increased fracking and oil and gas extraction on energy costs for consumers, and (2) the time frame required for such supplies to come on stream in comparison with renewable energy capacity.

\***Lord Laming** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of the quality of life of children in care.

\***Lord Purvis of Tweed** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of recent events in Iran and the impact of those events on women's rights in that country.

**Business of the House** The Lord Privy Seal (Lord True) to move that, in the event of the Health and Social Care Levy (Repeal) Bill having been brought from the House of Commons, Standing Order 44 (*No two stages of a Bill to be taken on one day*) be dispensed with on Monday 17 October to allow the Bill to be taken through all its remaining stages that day.

**Built Environment** The Senior Deputy Speaker to move that Baroness Eaton be appointed a member of the Select Committee, in place of Baroness Neville-Rolfe; and that Lord Moylan be appointed chair of the Select Committee.
