\***The Lord Bishop of St Albans** to ask His Majesty's Government what assessment they have made of Russia's use of drone attacks against Ukraine.

\***Baroness Donaghy** to ask His Majesty's Government what steps they intend to take (1) to increase the number of rape prosecutions, and (2) to provide more support for women and men affected by rape.

\***Baroness Bakewell** to ask His Majesty's Government when they intend to give legal recognition to humanist marriages.

\***Lord Green of Deddington** to ask His Majesty's Government how they intend to meet their commitment to reduce net migration, given the estimate by the Office for National Statistics, published on 24 November, that net international migration to the United Kingdom was 504,000 for the year ending June 2022.

**Export Control (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations 2022** Viscount Younger of Leckie to move that the draft Regulations laid before the House on 20 October be approved.

**Internal Market Information System Regulations (Amendment etc.) Regulations 2021** Lord Callanan to move that the draft Regulations laid before the House on 20 July 2021 be approved.

**Food and Feed (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2022** Lord Markham to move that the draft Regulations laid before the House on 24 October be approved.

**Baroness Penn** to move that this House takes note of the Autumn Statement 2022.
